



## WARGRAVE & SHIPLAKE REGATTA

### Arrangements for Practice 2026

Practice will be held from two sites in Wargrave and Shiplake again this year, from Thursday 23rd July to Wednesday 5th August inclusive.

### General Conditions

- Only those persons/crews who have completed and submitted an Entry Form and agreed to the Conditions of Entry may use Regatta boats.
- Practising crews must remain on the Regatta course and stay in sight of both Wargrave Boat Club and the General Start.
- River Rules apply at all times.
- A nominal charge per boat per half hour applies.
- All boats must be cleaned and bailed after use and any damage reported.
- Misuse of boats or facilities may lead to refusal of entry.

**The regatta operates under the same Rules and Safety Regulations as Wargrave Boat Club during Practice and Training Days, these can be read in the Blue Practice Books kept by the Practice Supervisor on Duty, the main points are summarised below:**

- Juniors (under 17 on Saturday 8 August 2026) must be accompanied by an adult.
- Juniors under 12 on Saturday 8 August 2026 **must wear a buoyancy aid.**
- **All Canoe competitors must wear a buoyancy aid.**
- Missed bookings remain chargeable.
- Bookings after 6pm are charged at the adult rate.

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## GUIDANCE ON USING THE BOOKING SYSTEM

1. Go to the URL: <https://wsregatta.co.uk/book-practice/>
2. Select the W&SR Practice Location for both Wargrave and Shiplake practices.
3. Select the boat type you would like to book at the applicable Wargrave or Shiplake location.
4. Available dates and time slots are shown on the calendar.
5. Junior Skiffs are available until 6pm after which time all skiffs are charged at the adult rate.
6. Either select  to book more slots or click
7. Enter your name, email and phone number.
8. Check your summary of booked practices and **scroll down** to enter card details to checkout and pay.
9. You will receive email confirmation of your bookings. Please bring with you to the practices.
10. Subject to availability, bookings can be rescheduled or cancelled 24 hours or more in advance from the My Bookings page linked in your confirmation email.
11. To access your bookings online, you will first need to create a “WordPress” password through the link sent to you in a separate email (apologies, this is slightly annoying!).
